### Guidelines for the Prospective Contributors/Writers:

1. The ICF Alumni are invited to submit articles for the book. The material must be about peace issues, peacebuilding, and interfaith peace efforts.
2. The book will be open to the ICF alumni and aims to reach a general readership.
3. For Part I: The essays should be within 3,000 to 3,500 words. Please use *Chicago Manual of Style* for documentation or citation of sources.
4. For Part II. The stories of peacebuilding journey of an alumnus/a should be within 2,000-2,500 words.
5. Entries or submissions must be sent as a Word document, Times New Roman font 12, double space.
6. Please provide photos to go with your stories with resolution 300 DPI; 2 megapixels (1600 x 1200) minimum
7. This book project will come out as an e-book, with a limited number of hardcopies.
8. The authors will not get remunerations, but will have access to the e-book and complimentary hard-copy of the book.
9. Writers, please send your full names, full contact information and a short blurb (100-150 words) and your photo.
10. The entries will be judged by the ICF Editorial Board
11. Deadline of articles: April 29, 2020.
